2. Introductory Provisions

- 2.1 The procurement procedure is realized electronically through the use of the JOSEPHINE electronic tool (hereinafter referred to as the "JOSEPHINE system") using all its functions.
- 2.2 By submitting its offer, the tenderer shall accept in full and without any reservations all the conditions of the Contracting Authority relating to the invitation to tender set out in the Declaration Notice of Public Procurement and in these Tender Documents.
- 2.3 The Contracting Authority expects the tenderers to thoroughly study the Declaration Notice of Public Procurement (hereinafter referred to as the "Notice"), these Tender Documents and other Tender Documents and to comply with all instructions, forms, contractual provisions and other conditions and specifications set out in the Notice and in the Tender Documents.
- 2.4 The offer submitted by the tenderer must be drawn up in accordance with the conditions laid down in the Notice and in the Tender Documents and shall not contain any reservations concerning the conditions of the tender.
- 2.5 All costs and expenses incurred by the candidate or tenderer in connection with its participation in the tender shall be borne in full by the candidate or tenderer, without any monetary or / or non-monetary claim against the Contracting Authority, regardless of the outcome of the tender.
- 2.6 The Contracting Authority reserves the right not to accept any offer and to cancel the tender if the proposed prices of all qualified offers exceed the amount of the Contracting Authority's funds intended for the performance of the Contract. The volume of funds intended for the execution of this contract corresponds to the estimated value of the contract according to point 4.4 of this Tender Document.
- 2.7 The Contracting Authority shall not conclude a contract with a tenderer who is obliged to enroll in the RPVS under the RPVS Procedure and is not registered in the RPVS, or whose subcontractors or subcontractors are obliged to enroll in the RPVS and are not registered in the RPVS. (*Translation note: RPVS means the register of public sector partners under the RPVS Act*)
